Come join us in La Junta for two days of singing with dinner on the grounds. Harmony Hall is a wonderful old community meeting hall dating back to the early 1900s with good acoustics and a convenient kitchen facility. Four and seven shape loaner books are available. If you are bringing seven shape songs to sing, please provide 25 copies.

La Junta is approximately 3 hours drive southeast of Denver and 2 hours southeast of Colorado Springs. This part of the state offers many interesting things to see and do. The Bent's Fort National Historic Site [<http://www.nps.gov/beol/index.htm>] and the Koshare Indian Museum [<http://www.kosharehistory.org/koshare/museum.html>] come immediately to mind, but there are others as well. For those wishing to arrive on Friday or extend your stay to spend the afternoon exploring the area, reasonably priced accommodations are available in the Mid Town Motel at 719/384-8010 and the Stagecoach Motel at 719/384-5476. For those inclined toward national chains we have a Super 8 at 719/384-4408, and a Holiday Inn Express at 719/384-2900.

From I25 North or South: Take US50 East from Pueblo approximately 60 miles to La Junta. Turn right onto Colorado Ave. at the light. Continue South to 5th Street. Turn left and Harmony Hall will be on your left just East of the Baptist church. Park on the street.

From I70 East: Take I70 East to Limon and proceed South on CO71. When CO71 intersects US50 West of Rocky Ford, turn left [East] into US50 and follow the instructions above for I25.

From US50 West: When entering La Junta on US50 turn right onto Colorado Ave. and follow instructions as above for I25.
